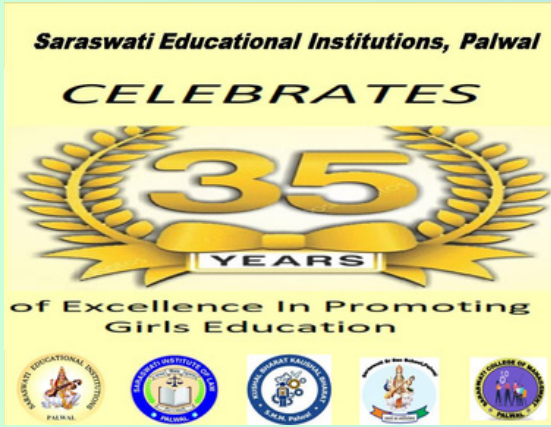

Guidelines for Author

Title Page: The title page should contain the title of the Paper; the author's name and the institutional affiliation.

Abstract: An abstract of about 250-500 words should include the research topic, methodology, findings and keywords.

Manuscript: should be of 4000 – 5000 words (A-4 size pages, double spaced and 12 pt. Times Roman font). The author should present his/her original work only.

Tables and Figures: the tables and figures should be placed in the appropriate location in the paper. The Format and size of all the tables should be the same and should be numbered consecutively in Arabic Numerals.

References: References should be complete in all respects in APA style.

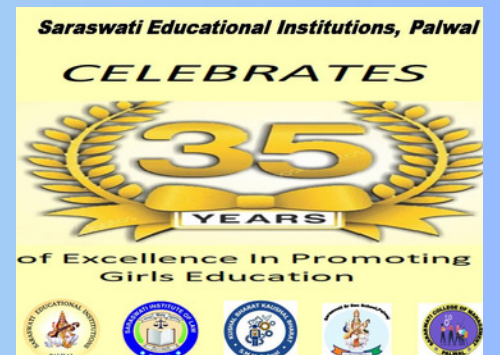
