Fear is the first and foremost thought that pulls us from stepping up. In order to overcome that we should be able to differentiate. Women under his ages took a miles to step towards. Reestablishing their identity in the society. Gandhi & inspiring ideologies boosted their morale and helped them to rediscover their self-esteem. Not only there was a general awakening among the women, but under Gandhi & leadership they entered into the national, mainstream, taking parts in the national movements. Gandhi & reformist spirit seasoned the role that he played in uplifting the status of women in India. With the emergence of Gandhi, a new conception of women gradually gained currency. For Gandhi women were not mere toys in the hands of men, neither their competitors. Men and women are essentially endowed with the same spirit and therefore have similar problems. According to Gandhi, education for women was the need of the time that would ensure their moral development and make them capable of occupying the same platform as that of men. When women given right education at right time. She can overcome the first hindrance in her life and she possesses self-confidence, patience and tolerance. Once a women realizes her strength. She breaks all the barriers and makes strategic life choices at all the circumstances for the betterment of her society, family and herself. Empowering women is the most essential to have bright future in family, country and the world, quoting to an African. Proverb "if you educate a man, you educate in individual but if you educate a women you educate a nation" Women empowerment is the utmost requirement of



Times Roman font). The author should present his/her original work only.

Tables and Figures: the tables and figures should be placed in the appropriate location in the paper. The Format and size of all the tables should be the same and should be numbered consecutively in Arabic Numerals.

References: References should be complete in all respects in APA style.
