About the Seminar

The Panchayati raj system in India is not purely a post-independence phenomenon. In fact, it's the most oldest dominant political institutions in our rural India from centuries also known as village panchayats. The meaning of the word panchyati raj according to India is rural self-governance system. Panchyati raj is the third level of local government which have 3-tiers, namely the Gram panchyat, the panchyat samiti and the zila Parishad. Article 40 states that the Indian states should take steps for organizing village panchayats with the endowment to have both power and authority self-government body. The panchyati raj as system constitutionalized in India through the 73rd Constitutional Amendment Act 1992. This act was passed in 1992 and came into effect from April 24, 1993. This act empowered state governments to take the necessary steps that led to the formalization of the gram panchayats and helped them to operate as the self-governance units. This the aim and objective of this seminar is to gain knowledge about the history of panchyati raj system in India. This seminar will give us an insight information about establishment of panchyati raj system in India and its detailed development. In this seminar, we will get to know how panchyati raj used to function in ancient, medieval British period. This seminar will also provide knowledge about women empowerment in panchyati raj and rural development, Gandhi's concept of panchyati raj etc. This seminar will be very beneficial for researchers, students and academicians.
